

EOPS Qualifications and Eligibility

In order for students to qualify for the EOPS program, students must:

1. Be a California Resident and/or AB540
2. Be enrolled as a full-time college student (12 units)**
3. Have not completed more than 40 degree applicable units
4. Qualify to receive the CA Promise Grant (Formerly the BOGG Fee Waiver)
5. Must meet at least 1 of these Educational Qualifiers:
 - Basic Skills Math and/or English placement
 - Previously enrolled in remedial coursework
 - No high school diploma
 - Underrepresented population
 - Current or Former Foster Youth
 - First generation college student
